11th International Senefelder Award ceremony

Offenbach, 7 November 2015 – The International Senefelder Foundation has presented the Senefelder Award to artists for the 11th time. It is the most generously endowed prize in this category with prize money of EUR 15,000 and was awarded in honour of special achievements in the field of lithography. The international jury selected the winners from over 130 entries from all over the world.

The award ceremony was held on Friday, 6th November 2015 at a public ceremony in the "Haus der Stadtgeschichte" (Local History Museum) in Offenbach am Main.

The prizewinners were:

1st prize € 7, 500

Anna Trojanowska, Kamieniec, Wroclaw (Poland)

2nd prize € 5, 000

Nora Leitholf, Düsseldorf (Germany)

3rd prize € 1, 250

Alena Klatikova, Novi Sad (Serbia)

3rd prize € 1, 250 (*Two third prizes were awarded in this competition!*)

Herman Noordermeer, Goutum (Netherlands)

Selected lithographs by participating artists who did not win a prize were also on display in an exhibition. Mo Andre provided the musical framework programme.
