Call for entries to the 11th International Senefelder Award

The prize will be awarded in memory of Alois Senefelder, the inventor of the printing technique of lithography, by the International Senefelder Foundation and the Federal Association of Visual Artists (Bundesverband Bildender Künstlerinnen und Künstler BBK) (for the 11th time) in recognition of extraordinary performances in the field of artistic lithography and its further development as flat-bed printing.

A total of Euro 15,000 prize money will be distributed
(1st prize Euro 7,500, 2nd prize Euro 5,000, 3rd prize Euro 2,500).

The closing date for entries is June 1st, 2015 (date on which mail must be received by the foundation). The awards ceremony will be held in Offenbach on November 6th, 2015 – Alois Senefelder's 245th birthday.
